Dear Smart City Media,

I'm writing to express our excitement and thanks for being the first university in the United States to install CityPost digital kiosks. The project was a win for our University of Missouri-Kansas City and a win for our greater Kansas City metro area.

For the project, we worked closely with Smart City Media LLC and its installation vendor, Duke Energy, to install eight kiosks on UMKC's Volker and Health Sciences campuses. These join a citywide system of kiosks that stretch along Kansas City's streetcar route, from Union Station to the River Market. Smart City partnered with UMKC to develop funding for the project that did not include public or tuition dollars, an important aspect for an urban-serving public university.

The 7-foot-tall, touch-screen digital kiosks now are part of a communication network that broadcasts realtime, location-based information and alerts to provide safer, better connected public digital solutions. Information is powered by 55-inch smart screens and a companion CityPost mobile application. Through the distinctive, UMKC-branded kiosks, students, faculty and staff, along with visitors to campus, can learn about student services, dining options, UMKC and KC events, where to find art and sporting events and more. The kiosks also include local news, bike-rental info, walking maps and, even, a selfie app. Plus, information can be translated into nine languages in addition to English, for our international students and visitors.

The Smart City and Duke Energy teams worked closely with staff from our facilities, IT and marketing and communications groups to develop and install the project. The process was collaborative and collegial – and highly successful. The kiosks have generated significant positive attention for our campus and have been a great service to our community.

UMKC's Chancellor C. Mauli Agrawal had this to say at the launch of the kiosks: "As Kansas City's university, we are committed to connecting our community to the rich resources available in our city. We're thrilled to be the first university in the nation to benefit from CityPost kiosks. Leading on the forefront of change and progress fits our vision of what UMKC should be all about.
